**Chief's Report** 

The Battalion Chief process is progressing. Six candidates have been chosen to be interviewed.

The interview panel will narrow the field down to the top three candidates.

The Washington Township Fire Chief advised the District that the Mad River Road and

Alexanderville Road will be closed for six months. The Township Chief asked the District to

provided mutual aid for structure fires only. Both Station 52 and 55 will be able to assist with

this request during this timeframe.

The District has received a grant for 100 smoke detectors.

Air 54 was sold on govdeal.com for \$23,400.

WHIO ran a story regarding fire hydrants that are located in Miami Township that are out of

service. The out of service fire hydrants are covered with a trash bag. This is normal practice for

the District.

The County Auditor has certified the estimated property tax revenue for Miami Valley Fire

District. The total assessed valuation is \$1,191,266,960. 95% collection of the levy would equate

to \$12,448,740.
