The resolution will allow the District Clerk to create a trust fund pursuant to Section 9.39 of the Ohio Revised Code for any unclaimed money to be held for a period of five years or until such funds are claimed. A motion was made by Ms. Allen, seconded by Mr. Fritsch, to read Resolution No. 2024-03 by title only. Mr. Stalder aye, Ms. Allen aye, Mr. Bell abstain, Mr. Fritsch aye and Mr. Posey. Motion carried. **A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE UNCLAIMED MONEY FUND FOR THE MIAMI VALLEY FIRE DISTRICT, EFFECTIVE RETROACTIVELY TO JANUARY 1, 2024.** A motion was made by Ms. Allen, seconded by Mr. Fritsch, to adopt Resolution No. 2024-03. Mr. Stalder aye, Ms. Allen aye, Mr. Bell abstain, Mr. Fritsch aye and Mr. Posey. Motion carried.

Motion carried. **A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE FIRE CHIEF TO PURCHASE A FIRE ENGINE APPARATUS AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT.** A motion was made by Mr. Fritsch, seconded by Ms. Allen, to adopt Resolution No. 2024-04. Mr. Stalder aye, Ms. Allen aye, Mr. Bell aye, Mr. Fritsch aye and Mr. Posey aye. Motion carried.

Chief Barnett presented **Resolution No. 2024-05**. The resolution will authorize the Fire Chief to purchase a medic apparatus and associated equipment not to exceed \$400,000. A motion was made by Ms. Allen, seconded by Mr. Fritsch, to read Resolution No. 2024-05 by title only. Mr. Stalder aye, Ms. Allen aye, Mr. Bell aye, Mr. Fritsch aye, and Mr. Posey aye. Motion carried. **A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE FIRE CHIEF TO PURCHASE A MEDIC APPARATUS AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT.** A motion was made by Ms. Allen, seconded by Mr. Fritsch, to adopt Resolution No. 2024-05. Mr. Stalder aye, Ms. Allen aye, Mr. Bell aye, Mr. Fritsch aye and Mr. Posey aye. Motion carried.

Chief Barnett presented **Resolution No. 2024-06**. The resolution will approve the wages and benefits for a new job classification within the service of Miami Valley Fire District. A motion was made by Ms. Allen, seconded by Mr. Fritsch, to read Resolution No. 2024-06 by title only. Mr. Stalder aye, Ms. Allen aye, Mr. Bell aye, Mr. Fritsch aye, and Mr. Posey aye. Motion carried. A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE WAGES AND BENEFITS FOR NEW EMPLOYEE CLASSIFICATION WITHIN THE SERVICE OF THE MIAMI VALLEY FIRE DISTRICT. A motion was made by Ms. Allen, seconded by Mr. Fritsch, to adopt Resolution No. 2024-06. Mr. Stalder aye, Ms. Allen aye, Mr. Bell aye, Mr. Fritsch aye and Mr. Posey aye. Motion carried.

Chief Barnett presented **Resolution No. 2024-07**. The resolution will give authority to the Fire Chief to hire district employees based on an annually authorized employee staffing list. A motion was made by Mr. Posey to amend Resolution 2024-07 by adding "Section 6 - This resolution shall only be effective upon the receipt of an opinion from counsel for the District approving the described action under the Ohio Revised Code." Mr. Bell seconded the motion. Mr. Stalder aye, Ms. Allen aye, Mr. Bell aye, Mr. Fritsch aye and Mr. Posey aye. Motion carried. A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE FIRE CHIEF TO HIRE DISTRICT EMPLOYEES BASED ON THE ANNUAL EMPLOYEE STAFFING LIST. A motion was made by Ms. Allen,

seconded by Mr. Bell, to adopt Resolution No. 2024-07 as amended. Mr. Stalder aye, Ms. Allen aye, Mr. Bell aye, Mr. Fritsch aye and Mr. Posey aye. Motion carried.

Chief Barnett presented the Authorized Employee Staffing List for approval.

A motion was made by Ms. Allen, seconded by Mr. Fritsch, to approve the Authorized Employee Staffing List depicting the number of positions authorized to be hired by the Fire Chief on behalf of the Miami Valley Fire District.

Mr. Stalder aye, Ms. Allen aye, Mr. Bell aye, Mr. Fritsch aye, and Mr. Posey aye. Motion carried.

### Chief's Report

Chief Barnett acknowledged an award presented to the District by Dan Douglas for their support during Spring Fest in the Burg for 2023. The District currently has four open positions. One offer has been extended and that prospect is going through applicable employment testing. There are two employees on long-term leave that could be approximately 8-10 weeks. BC Johnson is working through getting the two new staff vehicles fitted with emergency lighting. As with many other vehicle accessories, the necessary light bars are taking longer to arrive than normal. Circulation fans that were approved in the 2024 budget have been ordered for stations 51, 53 and 55. These will offer noticeable improvements on air quality for these stations. The SCBAs which were ordered in 2023 should be shipping on March 12<sup>th</sup>. Requests for Qualifications of Design Services was completed in January and two of the design firms will be presenting to the Board later this morning. KZF Design will present at 10:00am and App Architecture will present at 11:00am.
