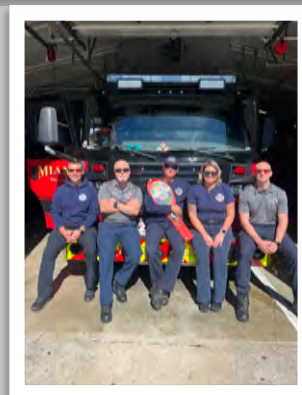

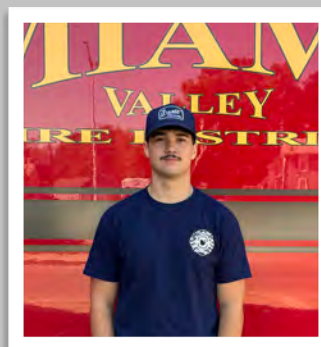

October 11th, Hunter Parker worked his first shift as a part-time FF/EMT

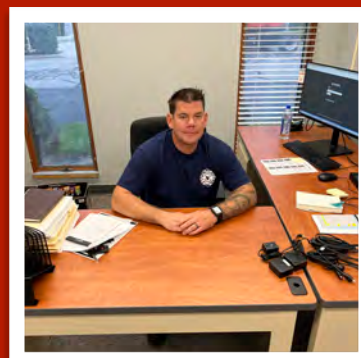


October 16th, Anthony Ascencio resigned from the MVFD and is leaving the fire service industry

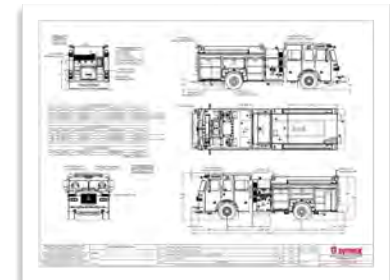
MVFD received photos of the cab of the Spartan Engine that is expected to be off the line at the factory on December 2, 2024



October 29th, Warren County Career Center High School Welding Class fabricated two forcible entry training doors for our Training Center



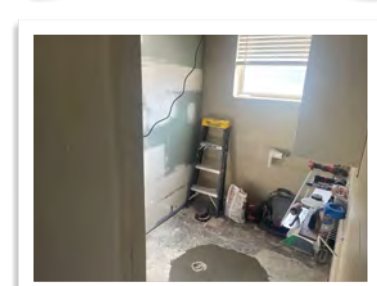
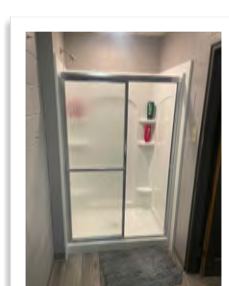
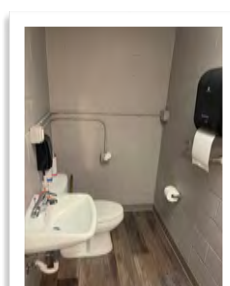
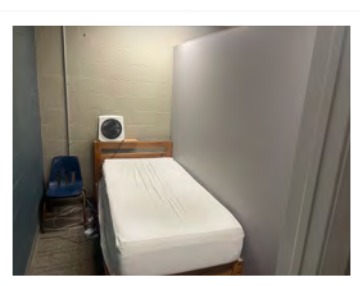
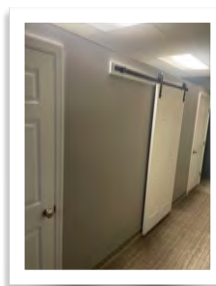
October 31st, Members met with representatives from Sutphen to discuss modifications to the specs for the Engine that is expected to be delivered in Spring of 2025
