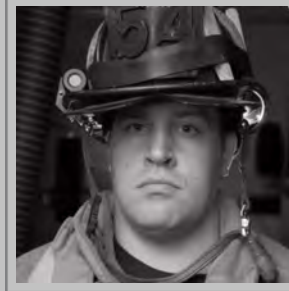

November 1st, FF/PM Lincoln Weizman passed his State of Ohio Fire and Emergency Services Instructor II Exam.



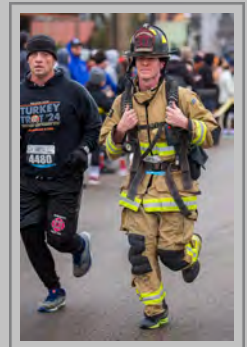
November 6th, Several members of B shift received Stork Pins from Kettering Health-Washington Twp. for a successful delivery in the field.

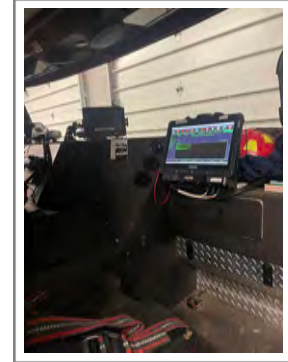
November 14th, Assistant Chief Null was sworn in at the Board of Trustees Meeting

November 21st, Interview Panel held an interview for a candidate for Part-Time Firefighter.

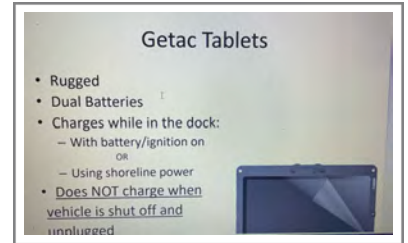
November 25th, Chief Johnson and AC Barnett attended a Zoom Meeting on Tenzinga Training.

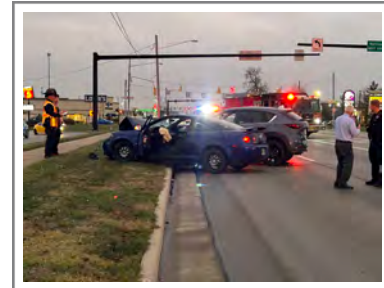

Crews responded to an MVC on Springboro Pk near Mall Woods. One removal was made from the scene.



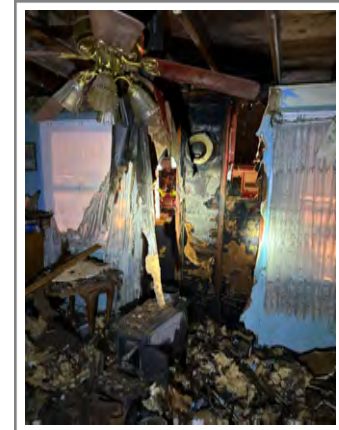
November 7th

Crews responded to a Dump Truck that had hydraulic fluid leak causing several accidents in the area of W. Linden and Albright Ln.

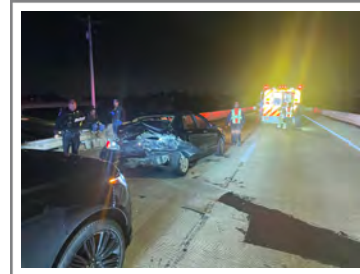


November 10th

Crews responded to a Structure Fire on Bearcreek Rd. No injuries were reported and fire is under investigation.

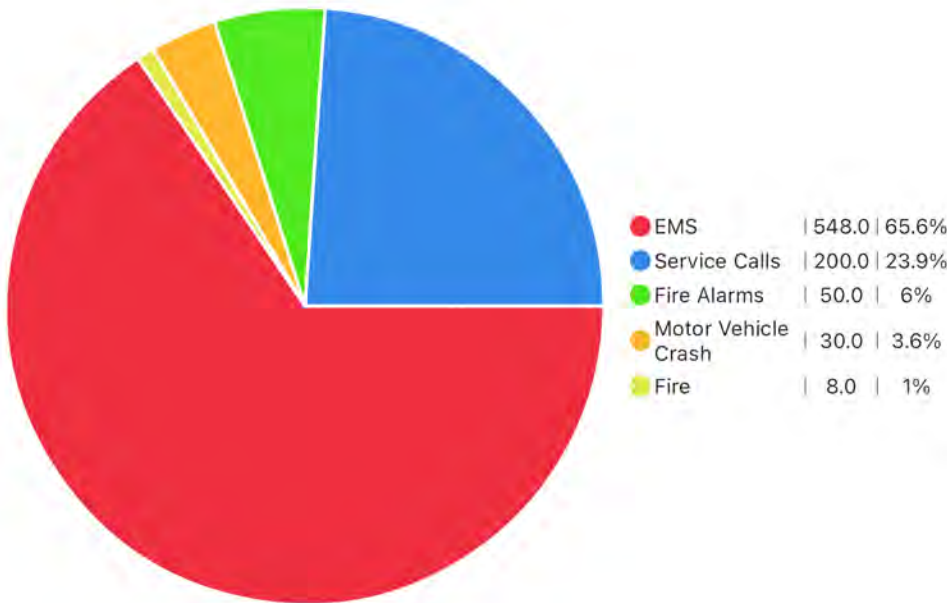

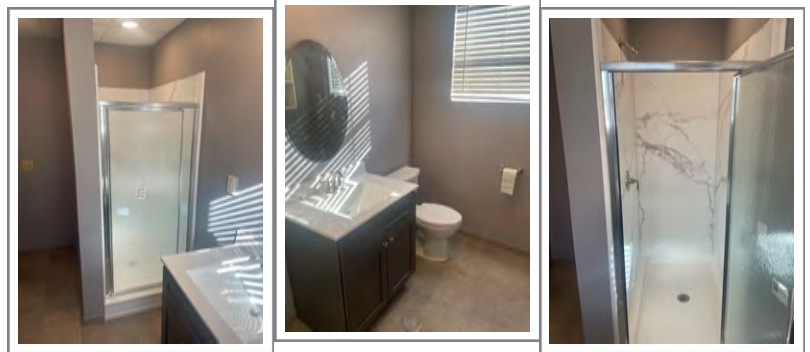

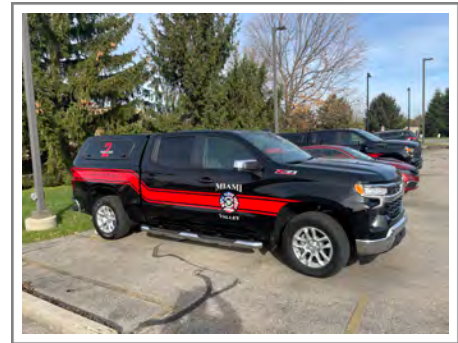
Capital Improvement and Equipment
