Crews responded to a MVC on Miamisburg Centerville Rd near I75

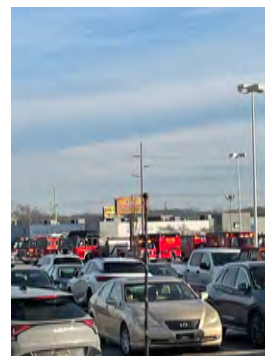


December 22nd

Crews responded to a Possible Active Shooter Event at the Dayton Mall.

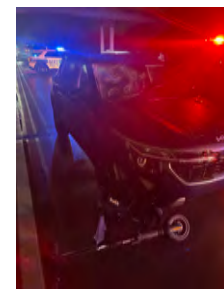
December 29th

Crews responded to a Vehicle vs. Pedestrian Accident on Springboro Pk. unde I675. One transport was made from the scene

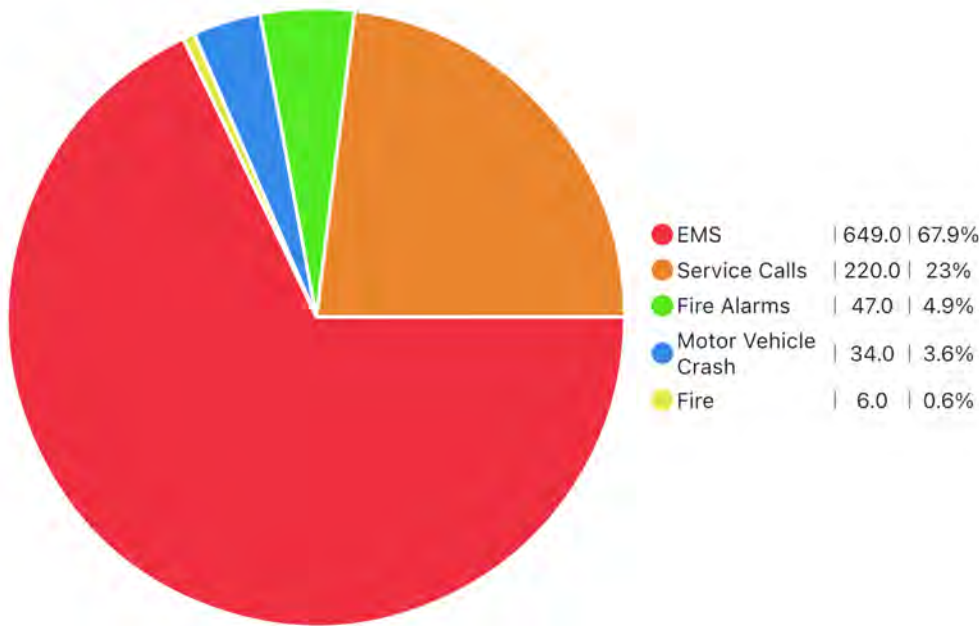
