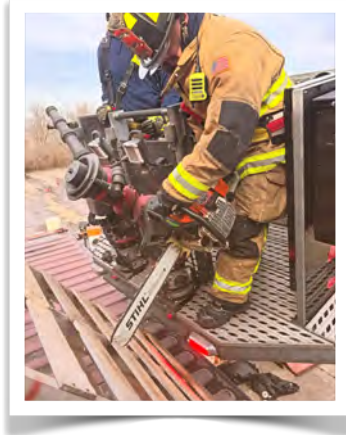

February 16th, During the Level 1 Snow Emergency that was issued, Crews responded to Multiple MVCs

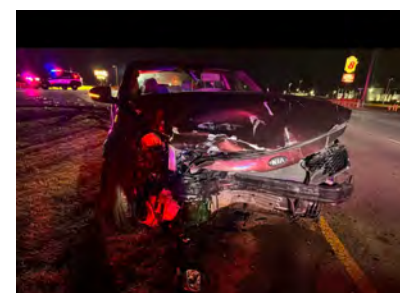
February 16th, Crews responded to a Structure Fire on Wrencroft Cir. Cause of the Fire is Under Investigation

February 27th, Crews responded to an MVC at the intersection of 725 and Monarch Ln. One removal was made from the scene

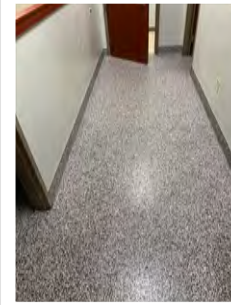
Capital Improvement and Equipment
