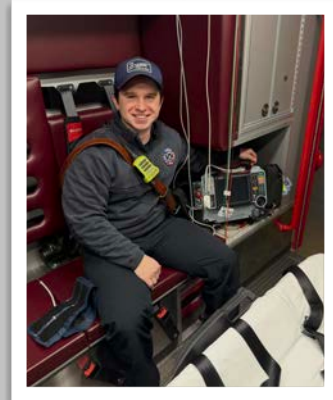

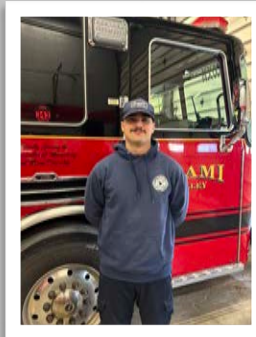
January 11th, Zach Kendig passed his National Registry Paramedic Exam and completed his Probationary Period

Lt. Brady Creech was awarded the Meritorious Conduct Bar for his continual contributions to the MVFD

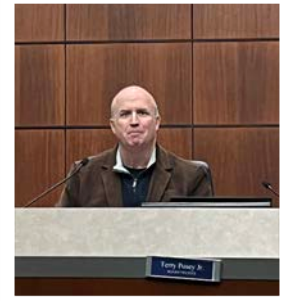


Operational Updates

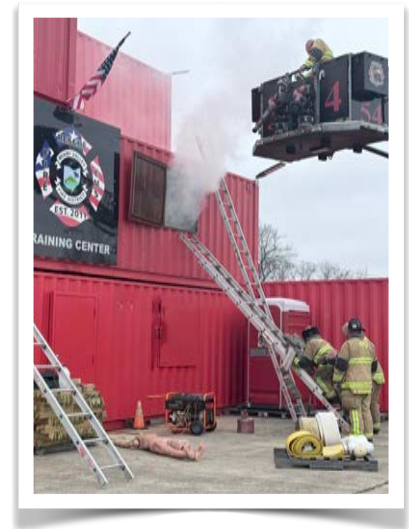

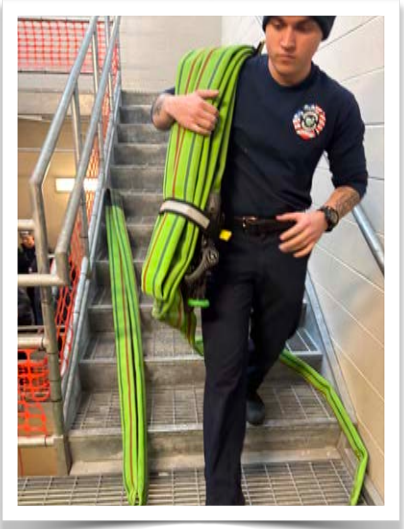
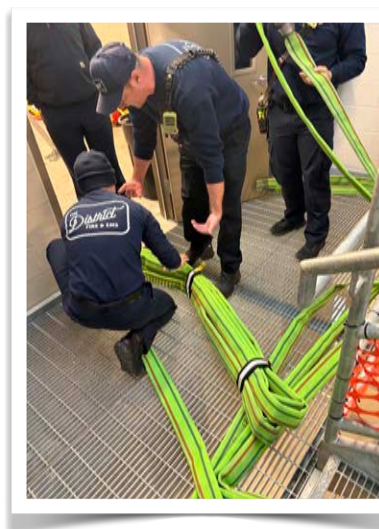
Training

January 7th, Crews responded to an MVC on Springboro Pk near Austin Blvd. Two removals were made from the scene.

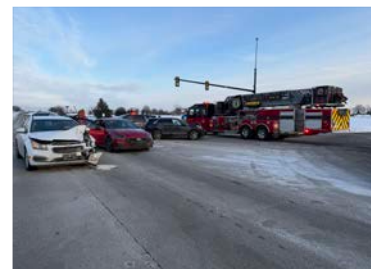
January 16th, Crews responded to an MVC on I-75 Southbound. MVC had one fatality.

January 29th, Crews responded to an MVC on 725 near Alex Rd. Two transports were made from the scene.



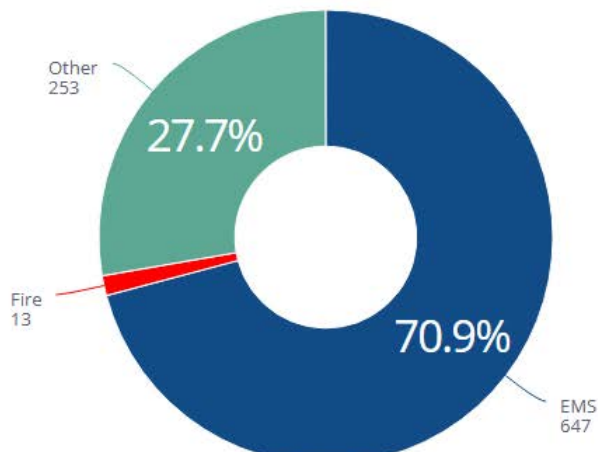

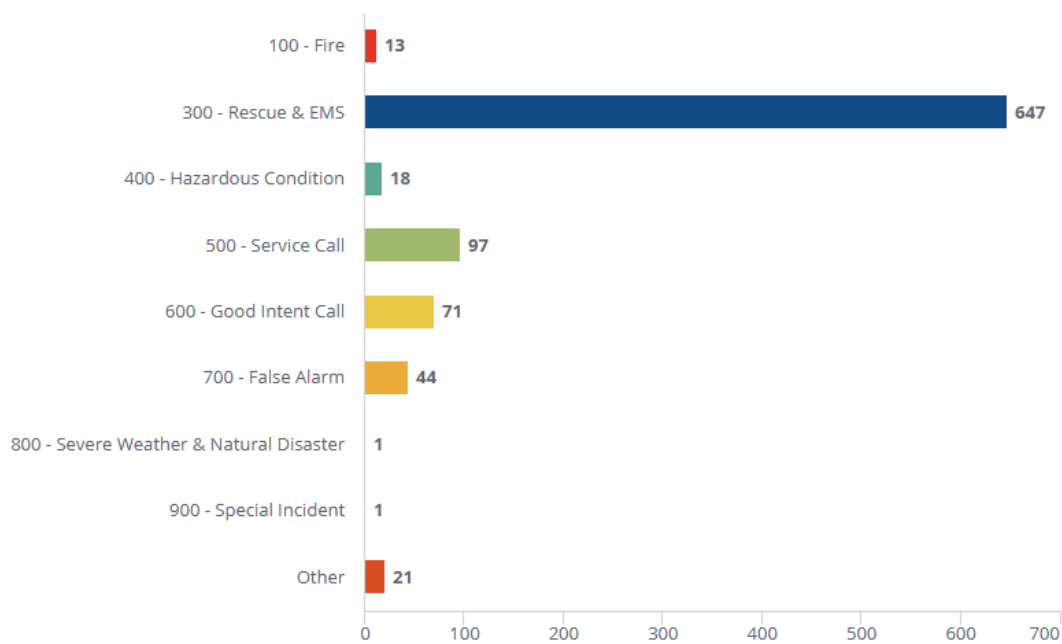

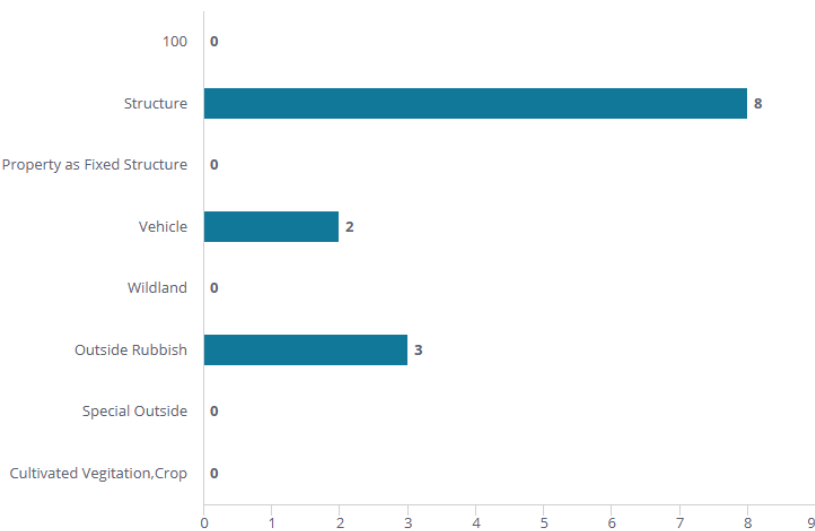
EMS/Fire Incident Breakdown



Incidents by Incident Type



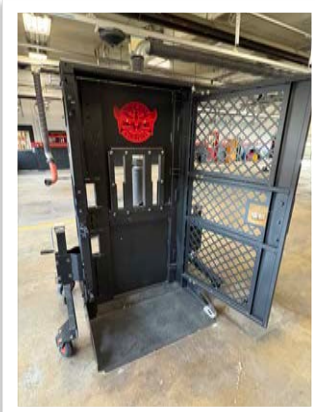
Fires by Type

An order has been placed for Lifts for Maintenance on all Vehicles



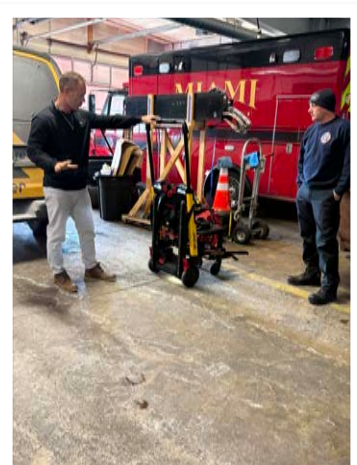
MVFD Board of Trustees approved the contract to purchase a new ladder truck from Rosenbauer. Expected delivery is 24-30 months.



A quote has been received to replace outdated existing Knox Box Key Devices on all apparatus



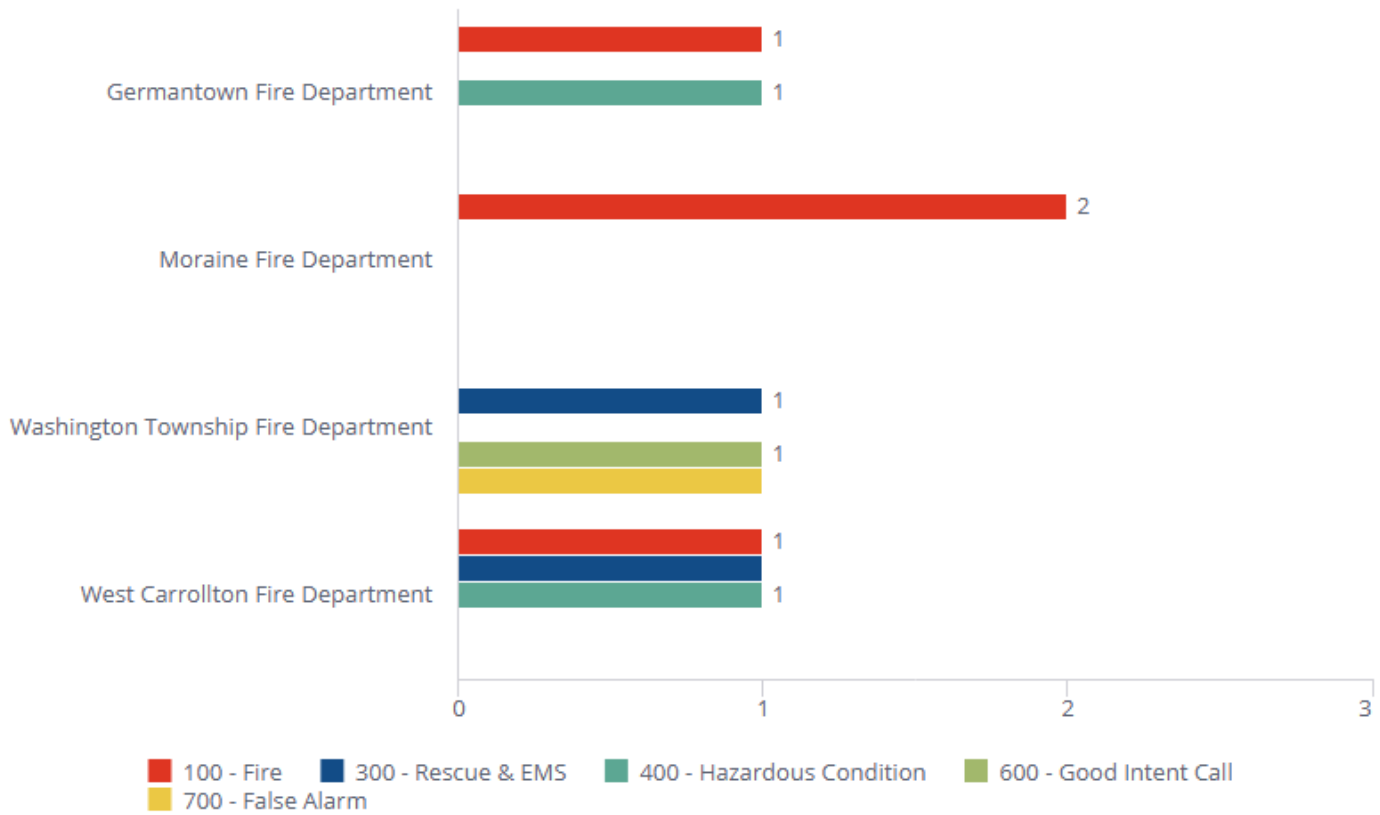
Crews demoed the new power stair chair from Stryker. Current stair chairs are coming to end-of-life and options for replacement are being gathered



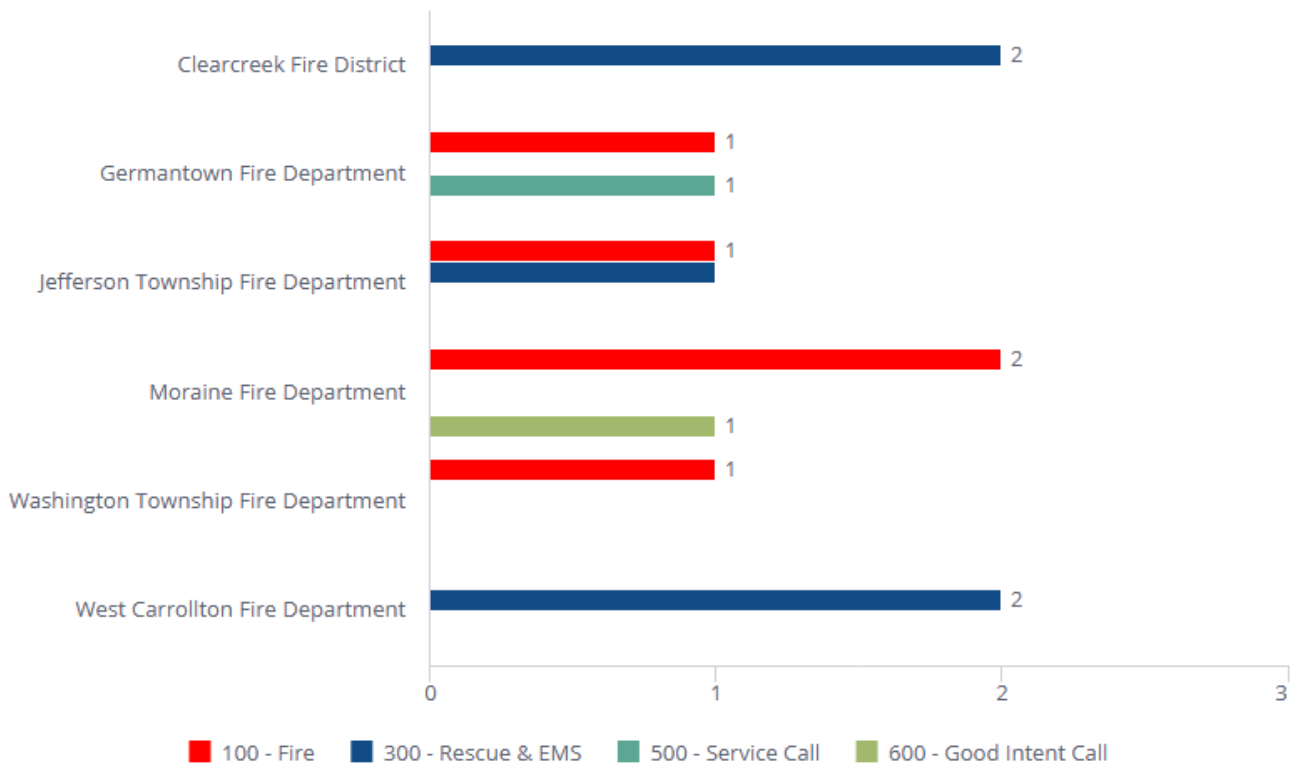
