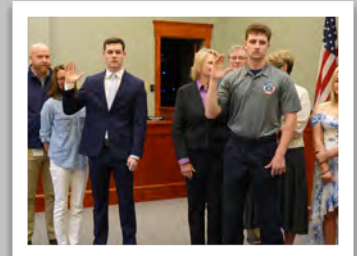

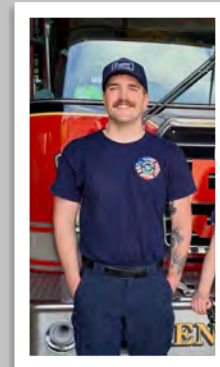
May 14th, FFs Bob Spirk, Jeff Tracy, and Ben McNeely were sworn in as Lieutenants

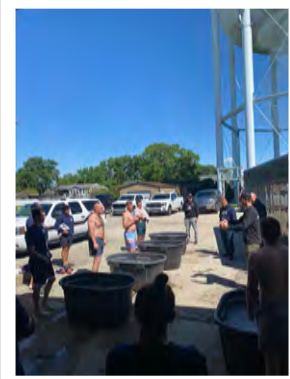

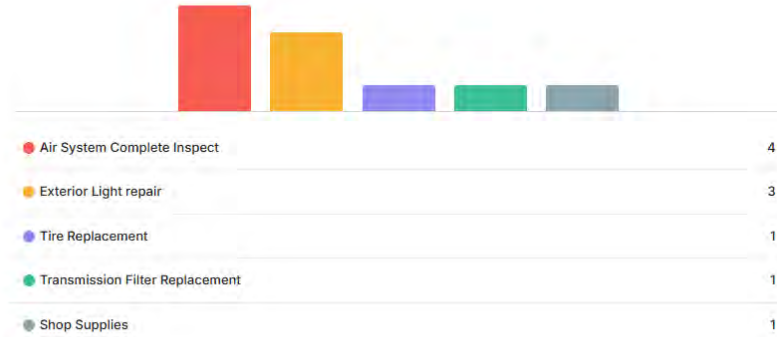

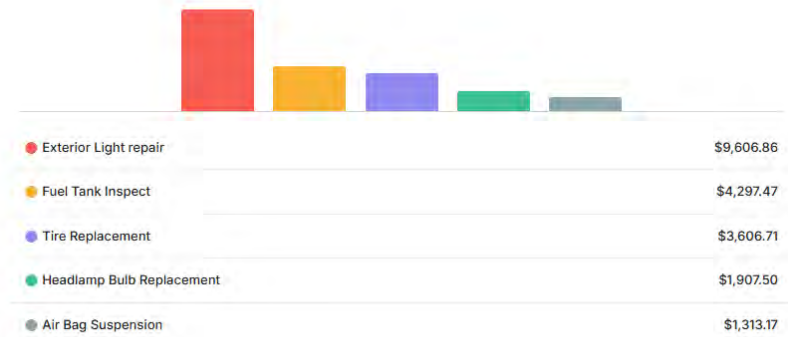

Top Service Tasks by Usage



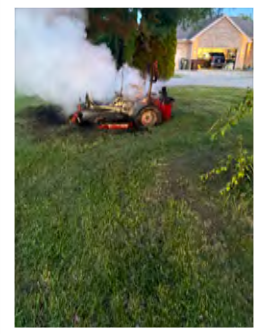

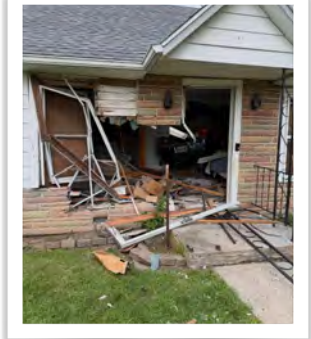
May 4th, Crews responded to a Lawn Mower Fire on Jamaica Rd.

May 5th, Crews responded to a Vehicle into a Structure on Miamisburg Springboro. One transport was made from the scene.



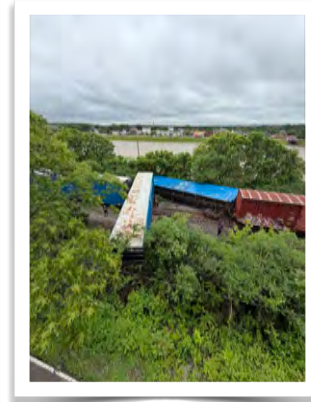
May 8th, Crews responded to Vehicle into a Structure on Belle Isle.

May 14th, Crews responded to an MVC on First St near Linden Ave. Two transports were made from the scene.

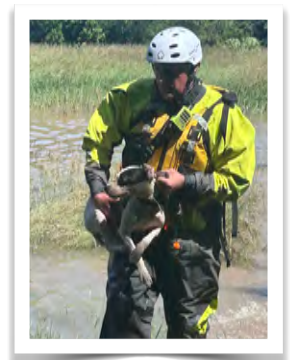


May 17th, L54 and BC50 responded Mutual Aid to West Carrollton on a Structure Fire.

May 18th, Crews responded to an MVC at the intersection of Rosina and Gebhart Church. One removal was made from the scene.

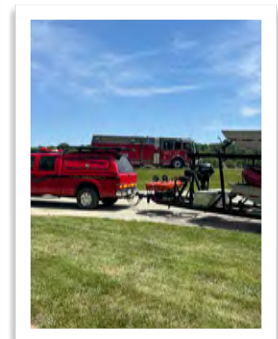


May 25th, Boat 53 and BC 50 responded Mutual Aid to Germantown on a Swift Water Rescue.

May 30th, Boat 53 responded Mutual Aid to Spring Valley for Swift Water Operations.

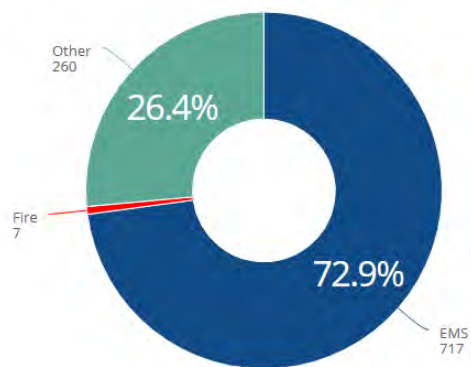

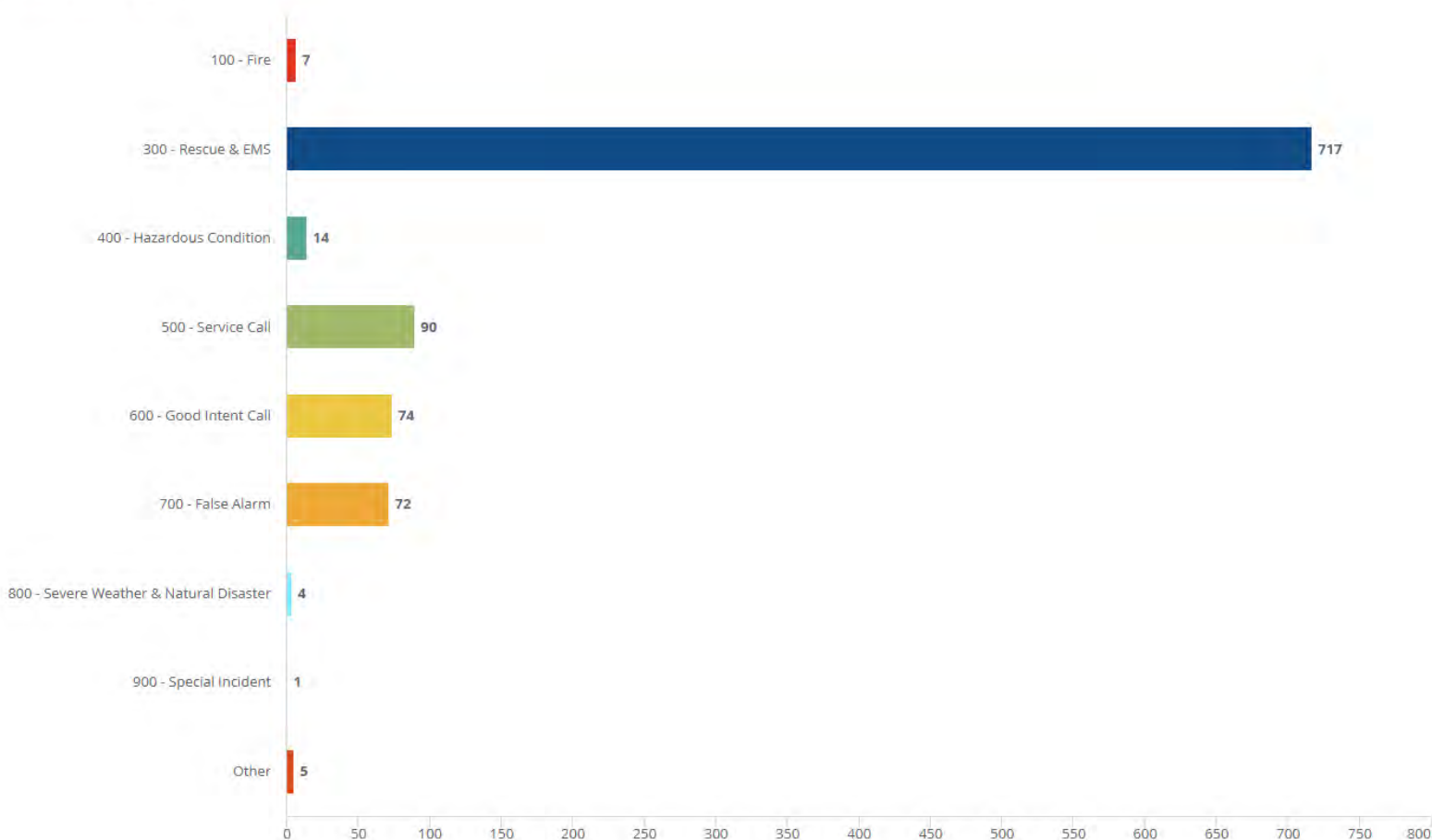


EMS/Fire Incident Breakdown

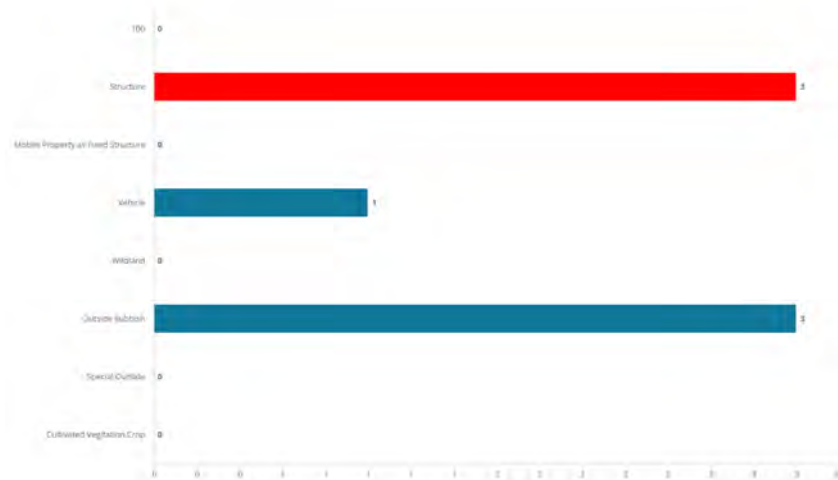

Incidents by Incident Type



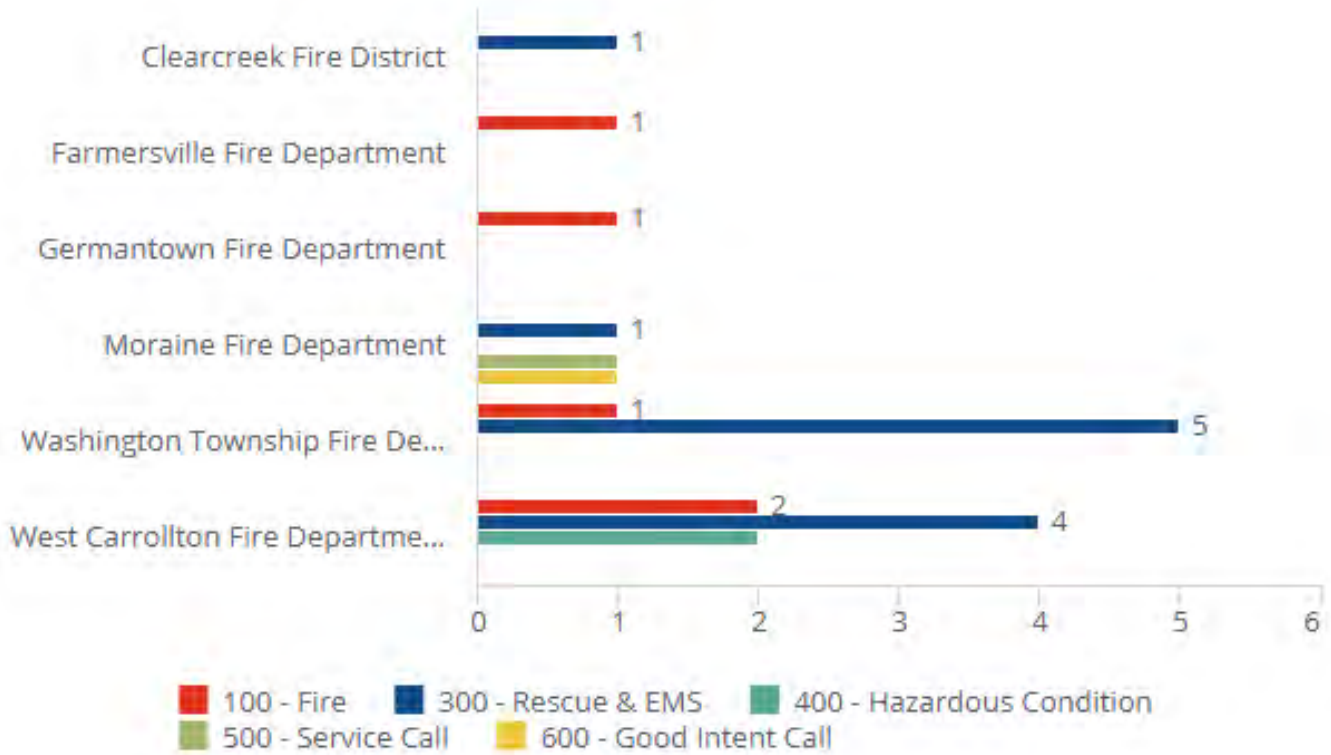
Fire by Type



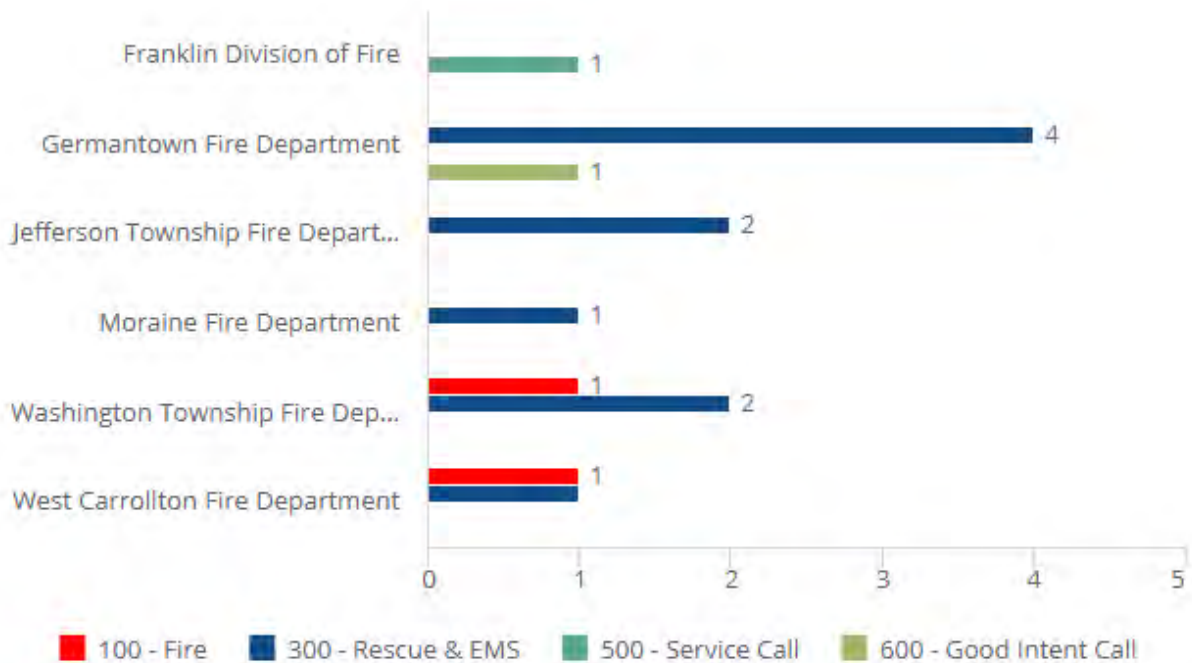

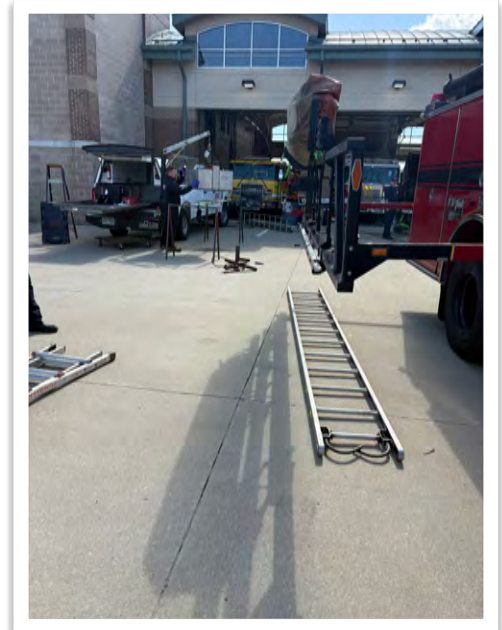

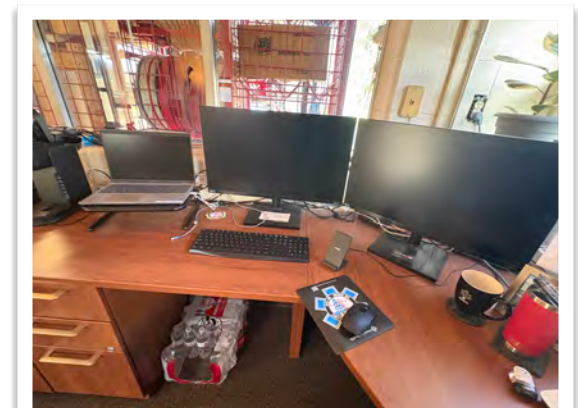
Annual Ground Ladder Testing was completed for all ladders in the MVFD during the month of May
